## Voter Registration Deadline for the State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters that **today is the deadline to register to vote and receive a Vote by Mail ballot** for the February 25, 2025 State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election.

Registering to vote is quick and easy and can be completed online at <u>LAVOTE.GOV</u>.

Voter registration applications are also available at most government buildings, such as libraries, the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), and the RR/CC offices throughout Los Angeles County.

Voters can <u>check their voter registration</u> to ensure they are registered to vote and their information is up-to-date.

If eligible voters miss the deadline, they will not be issued a Vote by Mail ballot but can still vote in person at a <u>Vote Center</u> beginning Saturday, February 15.

Translated election materials are available in 18 different languages. To request election materials in a language other than English, voters may call (800) 815-2666, option 3.

The RR/CC has created a <u>Senate District 36 Fact Sheet</u> with critical information on this election.
