## Vote Center Opens This Weekend for the State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced that the Vote Center at <u>Don Knabe Community Regional Park</u> will open for voting on Saturday, February 15, for the February 25, 2025 State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election.

The Vote Center will be open daily from 10 AM to 7 PM to vote in person or return a Vote by Mail ballot. On Election Day, February 25, these hours will extend from 7 AM to 8 PM. Voters can view and navigate to this location at LOCATOR.LAVOTE.GOV.

The ballot in this election focuses on the State Senate race for District 36, which overlaps with Orange County. The Vote Center at Don Knobe Comm Regional Park is available to voters living in cities in Los Angeles County, such as Cerritos, Artesia, and Hawaiian Gardens.

Voters can visit <u>LAVOTE.GOV/MyDistrict</u> to check if they live in Senate District 36 within Los Angeles County. Voters in cities in Orange County can find their in-person voting options <u>here</u>.

Eligible voters who missed the registration deadline can visit the Vote Center, complete a <u>Conditional Voter</u> Registration, and cast a ballot in this election.

The RR/CC has created a Senate District 36 Fact Sheet with critical information on this election.
