Additional Vote Centers Open on Election Day for the State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced Vote Centers are open for the last day of voting in the February 25, 2025 State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election.

The Way Out Ministries, RR/CC Norwalk Headquarters, and Don Knabe Community Regional Park Vote Centers are open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM to vote in person or return a ballot.

Voters can view and navigate to these locations at [LOCATOR.LAVOTE.GOV](https://locator.lavote.gov).

Eligible voters who missed the registration deadline can visit any Vote Center, complete a [Conditional Voter Registration](#), and cast a ballot in this election.

The ballot in this election focuses on the State Senate race for District 36, which overlaps with Orange County. These Vote Centers are available to Los Angeles County voters living in cities such as Cerritos, Artesia, and Hawaiian Gardens.

Voters can save time voting in person using the [Interactive Sample Ballot](#). This optional tool lets voters view and mark their selections on their smartphone or computer and instantly transfer their votes to the Ballot Marking Device with their Poll Pass (QR Code).
