Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk Responds to Bomb Threat at Norwalk Headquarters

LOS ANGELES — Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan confirmed the receipt of a bomb threat directed at its Norwalk headquarters.

Statement from Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk Dean Logan:

"Today, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's office confirmed receipt of a bomb threat targeting our Norwalk headquarters.

A thorough investigation is underway, and comprehensive security sweeps have been conducted at our Norwalk office and Ballot Processing Center. No threats have been found.

We take all such threats seriously and are working closely with the FBI, state authorities, and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department to ensure the safety of our staff and community and maintain uninterrupted operations.

These threats and efforts to disrupt the legal, transparent, and secure process of counting all eligible ballots have no place in our electoral process.

The safety of the employees working to complete the canvass of the election and the security of the ballots are our priority."
