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### Los Angeles County Adds Four Pop-Up Vote Centers in Boyle Heights for the November 4 Statewide Special Election

**LOS ANGELES** — Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the opening of four pop-up Vote Centers in Boyle Heights ahead of the November 4 Statewide Special Election.

The pop-up Vote Centers will provide convenient, in-person voting options for residents of Boyle Heights and surrounding neighborhoods from November 1 through Election Day, November 4.

“Boyle Heights has long been a priority for Vote Center placement in Los Angeles County, and we will continue that tradition for this election and all upcoming elections,” said Dean Logan, Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk. “Efforts to secure city facilities for Vote Centers under the short lead time for the Special Election were initially unsuccessful due to scheduling conflicts; however, I’m pleased to announce that in partnership with county, city, and community partners, we are able to add pop-up Vote Center deployments in the Boyle Heights area next weekend and a full Election Day Vote Center deployment on Tuesday, November 4 at the Senior Center.”
