

Clerk: Assists with opening and closing, monitors lines, directs voters to check in and voting area.

SKILLS



Vote Center Lead and Assistant Lead Skills: Strong communication, leadership, customer service and basic computer skills.

Clerk: Good communication, customer service and basic computer skills.

Bilingual skills are highly desired.
