Voter Registration Deadline for the San Marino Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters that **today is the deadline to register to vote and receive a Vote by Mail ballot** for the June 3, 2025 San Marino Unified School District Special Parcel Tax Election.

Registering to vote is quick and easy and can be completed online at <u>LAVOTE.GOV</u>.

Voter registration applications are also available at most government buildings, such as libraries, the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), and the <u>RR/CC offices</u> throughout Los Angeles County.

Voters can <u>check their voter registration</u> to ensure they are registered to vote and that their information is up to date.

If eligible voters miss the deadline, they will not be issued a Vote by Mail ballot but **can still vote in person at a** <u>Vote Center</u> **beginning Saturday, May 24**.

Translated election materials are available in 18 different languages. To request election materials in a language other than English, voters may call (800) 815-2666, option 3.
