



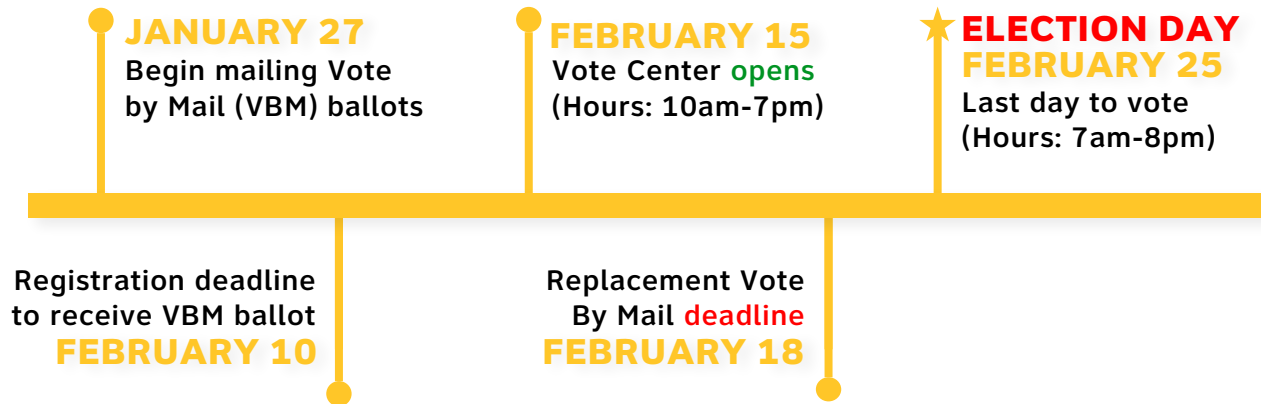

VOTE CENTER

The Vote Center opens on February 15th.

Voters can return their mail-in ballot at the Vote Center.

Newly eligible voters can register and vote at the Vote Center.



VOTE BY MAIL

Ballots begin mailing on Jan. 27th.

Sign and date the Return Envelope.

Mark and return your ballot early.



BALLOT DROP BOX

All participating drop boxes open on Jan. 27th.

Mark and return your ballot at any drop box.

Ballot Drop Boxes will close at 8 PM on Election Day.

All ballots must be returned or postmarked by Election Day

FAQs

1. What do I do if I need a replacement ballot?
 - A. Voters can request a replacement Vote by Mail ballot to their current residence or temporary address. The last day to request a replacement ballot is Tuesday, February 18. Voters can request a replacement ballot by visiting **LAVOTE.GOV/ReplaceBallot** or calling **(800) 815-2666**, option 2.
2. How do I register to vote after the close of registration?
 - A. Any eligible voter who misses the registration deadline can still register and vote by visiting a Vote Center
3. How can I request a Vote by Mail ballot in a different language?
 - A. Call (800) 815-2666, option 3 or return the Language Request Form attached to the back cover of the Sample Ballot Book.
