

RETURNING YOUR VOTE BY MAIL

Voters are encouraged to return their own Vote by Mail ballot using one of three convenient and secure return options.



Voters must sign and date their VBM Return Envelope before submitting the ballot.

Every ballot is verified before it is cleared for counting. If a voter's signature is missing or doesn't match the one on file, the County will notify the voter with instructions to provide a valid signature.

SECURE RETURN OPTIONS



U.S. Mail Must be postmarked by Election Day. No postage required.
