BALLOT PROCESSING CENTER ON ELECTION DAY AND NIGHT

- WHEN: March 5 from 7:00 AM Announcement of Election Day Semi-Final Results
- WHERE: 13401 Crossroads Parkway North, City of Industry, CA 91746
- PARKING: Limited parking will be available on a first-come-first-serve basis
- CREDENTIALS: Media members must present their credentials upon entering the BPC
- COVERAGE AND FILMING: Media can capture footage of activities in designated areas
