Semi-Final Results Announced for the State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election

LOS ANGELES — Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the semi-final results for the February 25, 2025 State Senate District 36 Special Primary Election.

A total of **5,607** ballots were processed and counted, with **10.87%** of registered voters casting ballots.

Election results for Los Angeles County can be found at <u>LAVOTE.GOV</u>. State Senate District 36 spans both Los Angeles County and Orange County; results for Orange County are available at <u>OCVOTE.GOV</u>.

During the <u>Official Election Canvass</u>, all Vote by Mail postmarked by Election Day and Conditional and Provisional ballots received on Election Day are processed and verified. Once verified, they will be counted.

The first post-Election Day ballot count update is scheduled for Friday, February 28. The full schedule of ballot counting updates is available on the <u>Canvass Update Schedule</u>.
