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L.A. County Begins Mailing Sample Ballots for the 2026 General Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced that mailing Sample Ballot Books to all registered voters has begun for the November 3, 2026 General Election.

The Sample Ballot Book is a valuable resource that offers essential election information on candidates, measures, and secure voting options.

The RR/CC will mail Sample Ballots through October 24 and will distribute Vote by Mail ballots to all registered voters beginning **October 1**.
