#### **Voter Registration Deadline Approaching for 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election**

*Register by May 18 to Receive a Vote by Mail ballot; In-person Voting Begins May 23.*

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds eligible voters that **Monday, May 18, is the deadline to register to vote and receive a Vote by Mail ballot** for the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

Registering to vote is quick and easy and can be completed online at [LAVOTE.GOV](https://LAVOTE.GOV).

Voter registration applications are also available at most government buildings, such as libraries, the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), and [RR/CC offices](#) throughout Los Angeles County.

Voters can [check their voter registration](#) to ensure they are registered to vote, and their information is up to date.

If eligible voters miss the deadline, they will not be issued a Vote by Mail ballot but **can still vote in person at any [Vote Center in Los Angeles County](#) beginning Saturday, May 23**. Voters displaced by wildfires do not need to change their registration and may add a temporary mailing address to receive election materials while away from home. The RR/CC provides translated election materials in [18 different languages](#). Voters can request their voting materials in their preferred language by returning the Language Request Form on the back of the Sample Ballot Book, or by calling (800) 815-2666, option 3. Spanish-speaking voters may also call (213) 358-2701 for direct assistance.
