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Vote Centers Open on Election Day in the 2025 Statewide Special Election

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced that Vote Centers are open for the final day of voting in the November 4, 2025 Statewide Special Election.

A total of 251 Vote Centers are open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM for in-person voting or ballot return. A complete list and online map of Vote Center locations is available online at [LOCATOR.LAVOTE.GOV](https://locator.lavote.gov).

Voters who still have their Vote by Mail ballot can return it at any [Official Ballot Drop Box](#) or Vote Center until 8:00 PM. Those returning their ballot by mail are encouraged to visit a local post office to request a postmark. Ballots must be postmarked by November 4 to be counted.

Eligible voters who are not currently registered can visit any Vote Center, complete a [Conditional Voter Registration](#), and cast a ballot in this election. Once the registration application is cleared through the Statewide Voter Database, the ballot will be processed and counted.

Media who want to visit a Vote Center or the [Ballot Processing Center](#) should complete the [Media RSVP Form](#) before arrival.
