### Vote Centers and Ballot Drop Boxes Are Closed for the 2024 General Election

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced Vote Centers and Ballot Drop Boxes are closed for the 2024 General Election.

#### Reporting of Election Results:

Given the extensive length of the ballot, the RR/CC anticipates the first set of election results will be released between 8:30 PM and 8:45 PM. These times are subject to fluctuation.

- **1<sup>st</sup> Results, 8:30-8:45 PM:** Vote by Mail ballots returned before Election Day.
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Results, 8:45-9:00 PM:** Ballots cast at a Vote Center before Election Day.
- **3<sup>rd</sup> Results, 9:00-10:00 PM:** Additional Vote by Mail ballots cast before Election Day.
- **4<sup>th</sup> and Recurring Results, 10:00 PM:** Ballots cast at a Vote Center on Election Day.

All ballots cast on Election Day Live election results will be available at [RESULTS.LAVOTE.GOV](https://RESULTS.LAVOTE.GOV).

When Vote Centers close, Election Workers will complete their closing procedures and deliver their ballots to the Sheriff's Deputies at a designated Check-in Center. Sheriff's Deputies then transport ballots from the Check-in Center to the Ballot Processing Center to be processed and counted.
