### **Eighth Post-Election Night Ballot Count Update for the 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election**

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the eighth post-Election Night ballot count update for the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

The update **includes 5,672 ballots processed since the seventh post-Election Night update**. The total election results count is now **2,217,796, which is 37.64% of registered voters**. Election results can be viewed on [LAVOTE.GOV](https://LAVOTE.GOV).

All remaining ballots are pending voter response and signature verification. Voters whose ballots require [signature curing](#) have been notified and have until June 24, 2026, to return the notice to have their ballot counted.

Given the significant reduction in outstanding ballots requiring processing, and with the remaining ballots largely awaiting voter response and signature verification, **the next ballot count update will be on Friday, June 12**. With the vast majority of Vote by Mail ballots now processed, ballot processing activities are expected to gradually decrease in the coming days. Accordingly, the RR/CC will adjust its operations to reflect the reduced volume of outstanding ballots. Hours of operation are available on our [Public Observation page](#).

The RR/CC's canvass efforts will increasingly focus on reviewing and processing CVR and Provisional ballots, and completing the [1% manual tally audit](#). The RR/CC prioritizes the timely processing, verifying, and counting of outstanding ballots in the [Official Election Canvass](#).
