November 3, 2026 General Election Logic and Accuracy Test

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) will conduct Logic and Accuracy (L&A) testing of its Voting Solutions for All People (VSAP) 4.0 voting system in preparation for the November 3, 2026 General Election.

Date: Friday, Oct. 9, 2026

The L&A testing is conducted before an election to verify that voting equipment is properly configured and accurately records and tabulates votes. The test will include tabulation of Vote by Mail and Ballot Marking Device (BMD) ballots.

RR/CC staff will use predetermined test votes and compare the results produced by the voting system with the expected results to confirm accuracy.

The public can observe the test at the Ballot Processing Center as part of the RR/CC's commitment to ensuring transparent, secure, and accessible elections.
