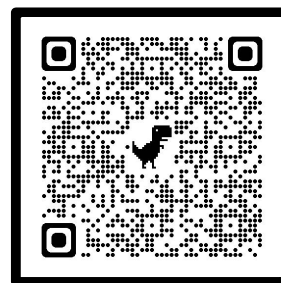

STUDENT ELECTION WORKER PROGRAM

GENERAL ELECTION: NOVEMBER 3, 2026 ASSIGNMENT INFORMATION

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Serve entire 3-day assignment at vote center
 - Students are assigned to a vote center within 5-7 miles from home/school
- Complete Election Worker training
- Assist with opening/closing the Vote Center
- Assist voters throughout the day

STUDENT ASSIGNMENT DATES:

3-DAY ASSIGNMENT

- Sat, Oct 31: 9am - 8pm
- Sun, Nov 1: 9am - 8pm
- Tue, Nov 3: 6am - 9pm
- ❖ Student election workers receive an excused absence from school for Tuesday, Election Day.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 16 years old
- Must be a US Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident (Green Card holder)
- Must provide a valid Social Security Number
- Must attend a public or private secondary educational institution
- Good Academic Standing (G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher)
- Must have teacher and parental consent

REWARDS:

- Earn \$100 for each day of service!
 - Bilingual Election Workers who speak a qualified language will earn a \$100 bonus
 - Stipends mailed 4 - 6 weeks after election
- Earn community service/service learning credit
- Looks great on college scholarship applications and resumes
- Certificate of Appreciation

TRAINING:

- All student election workers must complete the following before their election assignment:
 - 3-hour online training
 - 3-hour in-person training
- Student election workers earn an \$80 bonus for completing the required trainings

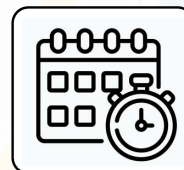

Students must complete all steps below in order to participate in the Student Election Worker Program and receive an election assignment.

Complete the Student Election Worker Program Consent Form.

Apply online at lavote.gov/studentworker.

☐

If your application is approved, log in to your [Election Worker Portal](#) to register for an in-person training class. Class registration opens on August 24th so please do so as soon as possible as training classes are limited.

☐

Log in to your portal to complete the 3-hour online training class. Online Training will be available beginning August 24th. This online class can be completed in multiple sessions if needed.

☐

Attend your scheduled in-person training class.

☐

Once you receive your vote center assignment, log in to your portal to verify your assignment details and click "Confirm."
