***2.190.090 Fundraising Periods:**

Candidates for Countywide office District Attorney and County Executive may begin fundraising 18 months before the election. Candidates for the office of Member, Board of Supervisors may begin fundraising 15 months before the election.

****2.190.100 Officeholder Accounts:**

No county officeholder who is running for County office may make any expenditures from his/her officeholder account during the period beginning six months prior to the Primary election , and ending on the day after the Primary election, or if the candidate is in a General election, ending the day after the General. This does not apply to the incumbent officeholders who are terming out.

*****2.190.040 Contribution Limits:**

After the Primary election (effective March 07, 2028), the contribution limits for all run-off candidates are reset to \$400 until the Form 800 is filed. Contribution limits may change depending on the candidate's and their opponent's Form 800 selections.
