MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTERS

Taking part in elections is more convenient than ever for voters serving in the military or living outside the United States. It begins when you register to vote as a military or overseas voter and receive election materials by mail, fax, or email.

✓ Are You Eligible?

To see if you are eligible to register as a military or overseas voter, you must be one of the following:



A member of the active or reserve of the armed forces of the United States



A spouse or dependent of a person in the armed forces



A U.S. citizen living outside of the territorial limits of the U.S. or D.C.

(All applicants with Military & Overseas Voter Status must meet voter registration requirements.)

Under the Federal UOCAVA Act of 1986, military/uniformed service members and United States citizens living outside the territorial limits of the United States or the District of Columbia for reasons of employment, study programs or military service (including the spouse or dependents of one serving in the military) are eligible to register to vote and request a Vote by Mail (absentee) ballot. This act is administered by the Federal Voting Assistance Program.

☑ Register to Vote

If you are eligible to register as a military or overseas voter, you can use any of the following options to register.

Online: California Online Voter Registration or Federal Voting Assistance Program

Paper: Complete the voter registration form from the California Secretary of State and do one of the following:

- **Fax** the form to (562) 232-7925 or (877) 614-1128
- **Mail** the form to: Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, Voter Records Division, P.O. Box 30450, Los Angeles, CA 90030-0450

Start Early - Los Angeles County begins sending ballots to military and overseas voters 60 days before Election Day. To ensure you receive your voting materials in time, be sure to register early.
