### **VOTE CENTER FACILITY CHARACTERISTICS**

### VOTE CENTER MODEL OVERVIEW

In 2020, Los Angeles County will transition to a new voting model that lets voters vote at any voting location in the County.

- Convenient, secure and accessible vote centers available for either 4 or 11 days
- Vote by Mail Drop Box Locations available for 29 days
- Same day voter registration allowed

- Innovative technology and top-notch security
- On-site staff to provide assistance in multiple languages

### ADA ACCESSIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All facilities must meet ADA requirements including:

- ADA accessible path of travel from the street/public transit to the front door
- 32" wide doorways
- ADA designated restroom
- On-site ADA designated parking
- Free of internal barriers preventing wheelchair access



# POWER AND NETWORK CONNECTIVITY

All rooms except the storage room need access to power outlets and internet.

Internet access can be:

- Hard wired (DSL, Cable, Fiber)
- Wi-Fi
- Mobile broadband wireless (LTE, 4G)



# OTHER QUALIFYING CRITERIA TO CONSIDER

- On-site parking spaces available
- Convenient access to public transit
- Hours of operation
- Rooms with locking doors

### **VOTE CENTER FACILITY CHARACTERISTICS**

#### MINIMUM INTERIOR DIMENSIONS

A vote center is made up of 6 distinct areas:

- Voter Line/Queueing Area
- Ballot Marking Device Area
- Kiosk Area

• Check-in Area

- Vote by Mail Area
- Storage Area

3,850 sq. ft.\*


These distinct areas would preferably be in the same room but it is possible to have the storage area and line/queueing area located separately.

The approximate square footage requirements for the voting area are listed below.

#### **FACILITY SIZES**

Small | Medium | 2,450 sq. ft.\*
